## Safety and emergencies

A hotel evacuation plan can be found by the door in your room. Our staff members are trained to respond to any emergency situations. Assembly points are noted on the fire emergency information on the back of entry doors.

Please make sure you familiarise yourself with your nearest exits and the emergency procedures listed here.

### Fire evacuation plan

Upon hearing an alarm, please leave your room via the nearest exit immediately.

Please use the stairs and do not use the lift under any circumstances.

Do not wait to collect and bring your possessions. Leave them in your room and assemble outside the hotel on the corner of Montreal and Kilmore Streets.

Do not attempt to re-enter your room until emergency services have given all clear.

We ask in such an event that you remain calm and follow the directions of the fire warden.

## Earthquake plan

If you are inside, move no more than a few steps - then drop, cover and hold. Seek safety under a table or in a door frame.

Stay indoors until the shaking stops and you are sure it is safe to exit the building.

If you are outside when the shaking starts, move a few steps away from the buildings, trees, street lights and power lines - then drop, cover and hold (if possible).

Remain in your place of safety until the shaking has stopped then proceed to the front lawn of the hotel and follow staff instructions.

Please use the stairs and do not use the lift under any circumstances.

Check yourself for injuries and get first aid if necessary; dial 0 for reception.

If you are in a damaged building, try to get outside to our front lawn if safe to do so.

Report any damage to reception.



# Environment and sustainability

We work hard to support our natural environment by undertaking a number of actions and making smart choices. We recognise the importance of taking these steps to achieve the best environmental performance possible whilst maintaining our boutique five-star hotel.

## Recycling

## Arrival and departures

Check in is from 2pm daily.

Please check out by 11am or contact us in advance to arrange a late check out. We will do our best to accommodate your request. Late check outs are subject to availability and may incur an additional fee.

Hotel Montreal practices eco-friendly laundry procedures. Leave towels hanging in the bathroom if you wish to reuse them. If you want them replaced, please place them on the floor or in the shower.

For stays over 1-night, sheets will be changed every third day to reduce dependence on energy and chemicals. Please inform reception if you require your sheets to be changed more frequently.

Please notify reception if you require extra towels or amenities.

## Dry cleaning

We facilitate a same day service Monday to Saturday (no service available on Sundays), except for public holidays. To use this service, complete the personal valet service form located in your wardrobe and put the items to be cleaned in the bag provided, together with the completed form. Bring to reception prior to 8am. Please note a 50% surcharge applies to overnight or express services. Any other requests may be made by contacting reception.

## Arts and culture



### Christchurch Botanic Gardens

10 minute walk from the hotel

A five-minute walk from the hotel, the Botanic Gardens are connected to Hagley Park making it the biggest, open, green space in Christchurch. Visit the green houses to see exotic flowers and plants, take a walk through the bush, or relax at Ilex Café.



### Art Gallery

7 minute walk from the hotel

Less than ten minutes from the hotel, locals and visitors alike have the pleasure of viewing some of the best art in New Zealand and the world. Experience a selection of historical and contemporary works spread over two expansive floors. Even the carpark is something worth experiencing!

### Canterbury Museum



10 minute walk from the hotel

Currently undergoing extensive renovations and due to reopen in 2028, check to see what temporary exhibition the space is home to during your visit.



### CoCA

8 minute walk from the hotel

CoCA (aka the Centre of Contemporary Art) is a slick and ultra-modern space next to the Christchurch Art Gallery. Inside, the two-story gallery plays host to a revolving seasonal program from local, national, and international artists.



### Isaac Theatre Royal

12 minute walk from the hotel

Christchurch's 'Grand Old Lady', the Isaac Theatre Royal is the spiritual heart of Canterbury's arts scene; an iconic theatrical venue that has played host to spectacular shows and spellbound audiences for more than a century. The atmosphere is truly unique with Edwardian architecture at its core and beautifully restored heritage features including the chandelier and breath-taking painted roof dome.



### Arts Centre

10 minute walk from the hotel

The Christchurch Arts Centre is a must-do. If you're in the mood for culture, you can visit the Teece Museum of Classical Antiquities, the Central Art Gallery, or the Pūmanawa community exhibition space. Fancy a bite to eat? Check out the many food and drink venues within. Maybe a bit of science will take your fancy in Rutherford's Den – a hands on interactive space, where Nobel prize-winning scientist Sir Ernest Rutherford studied. The Arts Centre is a great place to visit purely for a wander around to soak up some of its rich history.




## Local walks

### Kennedys Bush

 **25 minute drive from the hotel**

For something a little more intense, head up Kennedy's Bush Road to where the track begins. It takes you up towards Summit Road through private land so leave your four-legged friends at home as you get up close and personal to New Zealand wildlife and livestock. Depending on your fitness levels, it may take about an hour each way; it's mostly uphill with little flat walking. Stunning views!

### Mt Somers

 **1.5hr drive from the hotel**

For those who like to stretch their legs, try Mount Somers. It's a small village that is the gateway to an envious number of natural features like the Ashburton Gorge, Lake Heron, Lake Clearwater and Mount Somers itself. A lot of people travel here to do the Mount Somers track, a 26 km, 2-day walk that takes you past some amazing sights including some old historic mines. There are also plenty of shorter walks to do too, like the 45-minute Sharplin Falls track.

### Godley Heads

 **35 minute drive from the hotel**

The Godley Heads track is one of Christchurch's most iconic walks. This is because of the beautiful ocean, harbour and city views. The track also hosts historic military buildings remains and can be explored while you're there. Head out to Sumner then keep on going up and over the hill towards Taylor's Mistake beach to find the start of the walk.

### Bridle Path

 **20 minute drive from the hotel**


Christchurch is home to several beautiful walking tracks around the city that provide spectacular scenic views. The Bridle Path route was first constructed in 1850 for Canterbury's first European settlers travelling between Lyttelton and Christchurch. It's steep, but stunning views over the city to the Southern Alps, Lyttelton Port and Banks Peninsula make it worthwhile.

### Rapaki Track

 **20 minute drive from the hotel**

This is one of the most popular walks in the city with walkers, runners and bikers making their way up and down at all hours of the day. It's steep in parts but offers great views of the city, estuaries and ocean on the way up and views over Banks Peninsula at the top.

### Haswell Quarry Park

 **25 minute drive from the hotel**

Located on the outskirts of the city, this is a pretty walking area that is a mix of historic site, botanic gardens and panoramic views of the city in one direction and the Southern Alps in the other. It's also dog-friendly and suitable for all ages.

### Harry Ell

 **21 minute drive from the hotel**

If you enjoy exercise punctuated with caffeine, try the Harry Ell walkway and stop for coffee either at the top at Sign of the Kiwi or the bottom at Sign of the Takahe. The Harry Ell walkway is about an hour each way and offers perfect views of the city and Southern Alps.



## Destinations



### Akaroa

**1.5hrs drive from the hotel**

Akaroa is a French settled town with amazing food and beautiful scenery; perfect for a day trip away from the city. Swim with the native Hector's dolphin in the wild, or learn some skills at the brilliant Akaroa Cooking School which uses ingredients sourced locally. There are many scenic walks and things to see in Akaroa. Take in the relaxing sea air, visit the local boutique shops; experience small town New Zealand with a French twist.



### Kaikōura

**2.5hrs drive from the hotel**

Few places in the world can boast of such natural wonders as those offered by land and sea in Kaikōura. The seaside settlement is the most northern district in the Canterbury region and an ideal location for a day trip, no matter what season. Whether you enjoy just soaking up the surrounding beauty, walking the shores or more active pursuits, there's plenty to see and do in Kaikōura, such as whale and dolphin watching tours.



### Hanmer Springs

**2hrs drive from the hotel**

Surrounded by mountains, forests, and crisp air, Hanmer Springs is a picturesque alpine spa village 90 mins inland from Christchurch. You can do plenty – soak in thermal pools, explore the variety of walking and biking tracks, go bungy jumping or white-water rafting, indulge in a spa treatment, enjoy a range of cuisines, wines and more



### Arthurs Pass

**2hrs drive from the hotel**

Arthur's Pass is another small town that is a base for exploring one of the country's most revered national parks. The drive there alone is reason enough to make the effort, superbly engineered through the breathtaking wilderness of the region. The Devils Punchbowl waterfall is right there on its doorstep as a great reward when you arrive. The Arthur's Pass National Park itself has some great short and half-day walks where you can see some amazing flora and fauna. If you're lucky, you may even spot a cheeky and inquisitive alpine parrot called the kea.



### Lake Tekapo

**3hrs drive from the hotel**

Tekapo is precisely 3 hours' drive from Christchurch and one of the premier destinations in the country. If you haven't heard of it, chances are you've seen stunning photos of it. These photos might feature the Church of the Good Shepherd against the incredible backdrop of the Southern Alps and lake. You really are in for a visual treat, with picturesque colourful fields of lupins, and a clear starry night sky forming the backdrop to your own holiday memories. Tekapo is definitely one of the must-see spots of the South Island.





## Restaurants



### Riverside Market

15 minute walk from the hotel

This unique Christchurch establishment brings fresh produce, artisan bakeries, independent food stalls, bars and restaurants, high-class retail and eclectic market stalls all under one roof in a purpose-built, two-level establishment overlooking the Avon River.



### Earl

20 minute walk from the hotel

Earl brings a breath of European bistro culture to central Christchurch. The menu is crafted from the best ingredients on offer; simple food done well and executed beautifully. An open plan kitchen gives diners the possibility to observe the creation of their order while breaking down barriers between front and back of house.



### 5th Street

7 minute walk from the hotel

The team at 5th Street create fresh, satisfying, palate-delighting cuisine that enriches familiar flavours whilst introducing new experiences. With a regularly rotating menu, drawing from local and seasonal produce you can expect dishes that burst with creativity.



### Story

12 minute walk from the hotel

Story is located on Christchurch's iconic New Regent Street in an intimate dining space. Inspired by local and seasonal producers, the menu delivers a regularly changing 3 courses, all set in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.



### The Mediterranean Food Co.

7 minute drive or 27 minute walk from the hotel

For those with keen Mediterranean taste buds, indulge your senses with an exquisite collection of food and drinks. The team at The Mediterranean Food Co. offer an intimate and relaxed dining experience. It's also New Zealand's largest Italian specialty shop, offering the authentic Tuscan deli experience. If you need Gourmet cheeses, delicious Prosciutto and Salami wrapped in traditional Italian sandwiches, a vast collection of European wines, handcrafted gift hampers and house-made ready-to-eat meals, it's the place to be.



### Gatherings

10 minute walk from the hotel

Gatherings is all about celebrating Canterbury food sources without feeling too high-brow. The menu is very much plant based, a philosophy that relates to a desire to look after the planet and be mindful of what we take from it. Gatherings' menu changes frequently depending on what their small-scale produce makers can supply.



### 27 Steps

10 minute walk from the hotel

An effortless combination of old and new, 27 Steps is a sophisticated and modern bistro, where service, food and drink are up to a fine dining standard without all of the associated pomp and fluff. There is a distinctly modern take on the menu which features ingredients that are seasonal and, as much as possible, locally sourced. For once it's a menu featuring dishes that aren't necessarily designed to be shared, and that's a refreshing change. Expect big pieces of meat or fish topped with locally grown veggies and deliciously rich jus.



## Restaurants



### **Inati**

**10 minute walk from the hotel**

The Inati experience is like no other. Tucked away in a beautifully designed space on Hereford Street, Inati delivers a personalised dining experience that aims to challenge the palate and open the mind, with a raft of delicious plates, all designed for sharing, whether you're in degustation-mode or just wanting to share a snack with a glass of wine. Inati's wine offering is sourced only from vineyards and viticulturists known to the restaurant and sit perfectly alongside their memorable fare.



### **Amaterrace Teppanyaki**

**13 minute walk from the hotel**

Overlooking the Avon River, Amaterrace Teppanyaki is where guests can enjoy the finest Japanese cuisine expertly prepared by their chefs. Take a seat around the Teppan and watch the chefs expertly slice and dice the finest and freshest beef, lamb, chicken, vegetables and seafood right in front of your eyes. Or indulge in the delectable menu items such as crispy calamari, karaage fried chicken, prawn tempura and their signature Amaterrace special roll.



### **Francesca's Italian Kitchen**

**12 minute walk from the hotel**

## Wineries

### **Black Estate**



**50 minute drive from the hotel**

A winery, tasting room and restaurant, Black Estate is famous not only for its organic and biodynamic wines but it's refreshing approach to food. Locally sourced and organic produce gets turned into seasonal lunches at this Waipara eatery. Make sure you grab a seat on the deck above the vines. Family owned and run, expect excellent, warm and welcoming service.

### **Greystone Wines**



**50 minute drive from the hotel**

Greystone is a place where wine, food and people combine to create an experience totally unique to the Waipara wine growing region. Open 7 days, the cellar door is right on the picturesque Hurunui vineyard bike trail. Walk, bike or drive in to taste wines and enjoy a rustic platter, or take a picnic on the trail to see spectacular Waipara Valley views. Here you'll find award winning wines and famous natural ferments that are deeply intertwined with the land and a restaurant with a menu built upon foraged ingredients from the same environment.

### **Omarino Estate**



**15 minute drive from the hotel**

An award-winning vineyard just outside of Christchurch, this vineyard spans across 20 acres of verdant grapevines and expertly maintained gardens. Omarino Estate is the largest winery venue in Christchurch with a seating capacity of 200 guests yet a cosy atmosphere as a result of their secluded location.

### **Georges Road Winery**



**50 minute drive from the hotel**

## Markets


 **Christchurch farmers market**  
7 minute drive or 37 minute walk from the hotel

Held on Saturdays from 9am at Riccarton House this is one of the best food markets in town; an excellent start to your weekend. Enjoy live music, fresh food and more, set in the idyllic open-air grounds of the historic homestead surrounded by one of the last native bushland areas in Christchurch.

 **Lyttelton farmers market**  
22 minute drive from the hotel

Full of foodie delights, open every Saturday from 10am regardless of the weather, Lyttelton's main shopping street buzzes! Factor in the Lyttelton harbour scenery; friendly local people; and highly knowledgeable vendors – this farmers market is one of the best in New Zealand.
